- 1. Volunteers are needed for the Show! Sign-up on the OGS website: www.ohiogourdsociety.com, or contact Linda Rose, at lindarose@insight.rr.com. 740-971-9394. Cell/txt.
- 2. Modification of Competitive Entry Class 59: Jim Story Award. For 2022, the American Gourd society has added a new award category for The Jim Story Award. That category is for "*Multiple-Manipulated (Inseparable) Multiple-Manipulated (Inseparable).*" See the American Gourd Society website for additional details. (www.americangourdsociety.org/jim-storyaward.html). In order to support that new category, the Ohio Gourd Society is splitting Class 59 into two parts. Class 59 A will be for single gourds, and 59 B will be for multiple-manipulated (inseparable) gourds. Simply note on the entry form if you are entering A or B. You may enter one or both. For 2022 at the national level, the AGS has also allowed multiple entries from one person, and the entry qualifications now state that an entry place either 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in a State show.
- 3. Gourd Display at Kingwood Center. The Kingwood Center is located in Mansfield, Ohio at 50 N Trimble

Rd. This is our second year doing displays in the fall and for Christmas. If anyone would like one of their gourd creations used for the Christmas display, please bring to the Ohio Gourd Show in October. You may leave it at the registration table <u>attention Suzanne Rothhaar</u>. They will be returned at the next meeting, at the next show, or perhaps arrangements can be made to meet. Item can be shipped back, but at owners expense. We'd love to display a variety of projects, the more the Merrier.
